BIKE NETWORKS IN THE UNITED STATES



The network score evaluates the quality of the bike network — how completely it connects people to each other and local destinations using comfortable routes. Perceptions of the network are also given weight.

Americans want safe places to ride and aren't satisfied with the bike networks in their communities.

47%

of Americans say they would be more likely to ride a bike if pathways were physically separated from motor vehicles.

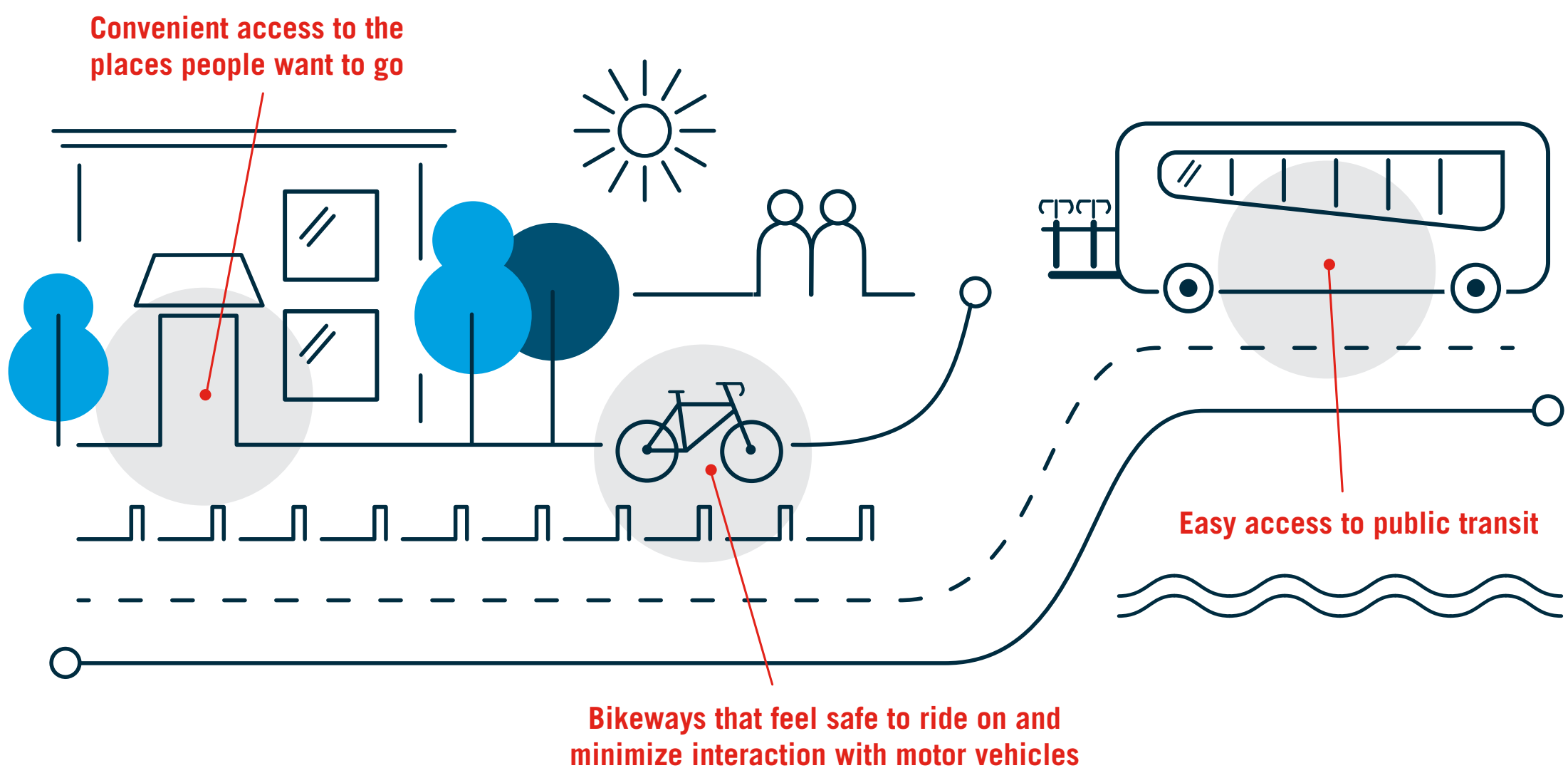
32%
